

Lutheran School of Nursing Articulation Guide

This articulation agreement is between Lutheran School of Nursing and Walden University.

Lutheran School of Nursing students who successfully complete the courses indicated in the tables below with a grade of 'C' or better *and* meet the requirements for admission to Walden's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Completion Program or the RN-BSN-MSN Program may receive credit toward their BSN program. **All credits will be converted to the equivalent value for Walden credit.**

Important Note: Courses indicated on these tables will be fulfilled, but there may be outstanding credit. Walden requires that 45 of the last 90 quarter credits earned for a bachelor's degree be earned at Walden University. Transfer of credit is subject to change based on curriculum updates by academic leadership.
