

North Shore Community College Articulation Guide

This articulation agreement is between North Shore Community College (NSCC) and Walden University.

NSCC students who successfully complete the courses indicated in the tables below, with a grade of *C* or better *and* meet the requirements for admission to Walden's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Completion Program or the RN-BSN-MSN program may receive credit toward their respective degree program. **All credits will be converted to the equivalent value for Walden credit.**

Important Note: Courses indicated on these tables will be fulfilled, but there may be outstanding credit. Walden requires that 45 of the last 90 quarter credits earned for a bachelor's degree be earned at Walden University. Transfer of credit is subject to change based on curriculum updates by academic leadership.
