

Sophia Learning and Walden University Articulation Guide

This articulation agreement is between Sophia Learning and Walden University.

The following chart indicates Sophia Learning students who complete these courses/examinations and meet the requirements for admission to Walden may receive credit toward their Bachelor degree. **All credits will be converted to the equivalent value for Walden credit.**

Important Note: Courses indicated on these tables will be fulfilled, but there may be outstanding credit. Walden requires that 45 of the last 90 quarter credits earned for a bachelor's degree be earned at Walden University. Transfer of credit is subject to change based on curriculum updates by academic leadership.

All courses noted below can also count towards lower level elective credits. No upper level elective credits will be awarded for these courses.

For Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education (BSEE) students only: Not all the Sophia Learning courses will transfer in to this program. Please see the BSEE only column below for appropriate equivalents.
