

Sumner College Articulation Guide

This articulation agreement is between Sumner College and Walden University.

Sumner College students who successfully complete the courses indicated in the tables below with a grade of ‘C’ or better *and* meet the requirements for admission to Walden’s Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Completion Program or the RN-BSN-MSN Program may receive credit toward their BSN program. **All credits will be converted to the equivalent value for Walden credit.**

Important Note: Courses indicated on these tables will be fulfilled, but there may be outstanding credit. Walden requires that 45 of the last 90 quarter credits earned for a bachelor’s degree be earned at Walden University. Transfer of credit is subject to change based on curriculum updates by academic leadership.
